Year Two Homework - Summer Term 2026



1. This term, we will be finding out about birds and reading bird poetry. Choose a bird to research. What information can you find? Make a poster with pictures and information about the bird that you choose.

2. During topic sessions, we will be learning about how the hot air balloon was invented and watching extracts from the beginning of the film 'Up'. Can you imagine what it would be like to fly up in a balloon and what you might see when you look down? Where would you go? Write a story to describe your adventure.



3. Design your own flying machine, like Leonardo Da Vinci! Label the different parts and add captions to show what they do.



4. We will be learning about the first moon landing and the Apollo 11 mission. Research information about the first moon landing to share with us at school.

6. Make a model rocket or moon buggy. Bring it into school to help to create a class display.

7. We will be learning about living things and about what they need to survive. Have a go at this Oak Academy lesson on habitats:
