2. Draw and label a map of where the Maya were located.
3. Can you find out about the story of the Hero Twins? Summarise the story in the style of a comic strip.
4. Can you research a Maya city? What can you find out about it? What was it like? Record your information using writing and illustrations.
5. The Maya were great farmers and enjoyed eating tortillas filled with cooked vegetables! Can you design your own Maya tortilla recipe? Perhaps you could even make it.
6. Paint a picture of a Maya God. Can you include some labels or captions?
7. Research two different things that were invented by the Maya. Create a fact file about them.
8. Can you draw or make a Maya temple? Write about why the temples were so important to the Maya people.
9. Bake a chocolate treat! Follow a recipe to make a tasty treat for your family. Can you write a set of instructions for someone else to follow?
10. Write a secret message in Maya hieroglyphics for the teachers to work out.
