1. Cover your new homework book and label it with your name and new class. You can be creative!
2. Produce an observational drawing of a bowl of fruit.
3. Write a simple set of instructions for making your breakfast.
4. Ask family members what their favourite fruit is and make a pictogram to record your data.
5. Use Google Earth to find your house, Purleigh Primary School, a famous landmark and a different country.
6. Take some autumnal photos. The photos can be taken by you or they may include you! These can be printed or sent to the Class 1 email. We will be creating our very own gallery of images!
7. Read a variety of fairy-tale books and draw your favourite character. Can you write a sentence about them?
8. Use your imagination to create an Autumn themed picture of your choice. You could use materials you have collected on an Autumn walk.
9. Draw a picture and write sentences about your own hybrid animal. What is its name? What does it look like? What does it feel like? Where does it live? What makes it special? Improve and extend your sentence using 'and' to join sentences or add an adjective to describe how your animals' fur feels.
10. Bonfire Night – Make a firework safety poster.
