Year One Homework Summer Term

This homework is all related to learning that will take place this term. Please complete one piece each week and hand in for marking once that piece is completed. You decide which one you choose to complete weekly but please comment on it on the attached sheet.

1. Use pictures from magazines or the internet to represent seasonal changes. You could divide your page into four sections, one for each season.
2. Find a photo of yourself at the seaside. Write about the geographical features and the favourite part of your day / holiday!
3. Draw a picture using your favourite colours. Once you have done that explain why you have used those colours.
4. Lighthouses - Use information books or internet research to write 5 facts about lighthouses. Draw a picture to illustrate your work.
5. Pond creatures! Draw and label 5 different pond creatures.
6. Look at www.topmarks.co.uk 'Learning Games'. Play a variety of maths games.
7. Floating and sinking experiment. Use a washing up bowl, or even the bath to create your own floating and sinking investigation of at least 8 objects in your house. Make predictions first and record your results.
8. Make a fish tank using a shoe box (nothing bigger please). Be creative!
9. Look at www.ictgames.com. Play a selection of maths and literacy games.
10. Sea creatures! Draw and label 5 different sea creatures. Can you research some information about these creatures using the internet and make a fact file?
11. Read a book that is anything to do with the water - it could be about the seaside, ponds, rivers or even the rain. You could choose a book from home, your reading book, a star book or a library book. The book can be either fiction or non-fiction. Once you have read the book - write a review. Think about what you liked or didn't like, the characters and the plot or information given.
