Human and physical features of the seaside...



- pebbles: small, smooth, round stones found by the edge of the sea.
- pier: a structure for people to walk along that is built out into the sea.
- cliff: a steep rock face close to the edge of the sea.
- harbour: a place by the seaside where boats can stay safely in the water.
- bay: a place where the coast bends inwards and sea fills the space.
- funfair: a place where there is a Merry-go-Round, other rides, stalls and shows.
- lighthouse: a tower with a bright light that warns or guides ships at sea.
- beach: land by the edge of the sea, usually covered with sand or small stones.
- campsite: a place used for camping, filled with tents and caravans.
- sand dune: hills or mounds of sand held together by plants, often near the sea.
