1. Carry out research to find at least 5 words that Shakespeare invented. List the words and a definition for each.

Write a couple of sentences explaining your favourite part and why.
3. Create a portrait of William Shakespeare – you can use any medium you like – e.g. draw, paint or collage.
4. Write an acrostic poem about Shakespeare.
5. Carry out research to write at least 3 interesting facts about the Tudors. It can be anything that captures your imagination about this period of history.
6. Create a Tudor Rose – know what each part represents.
7. List all of Henry VIII wives in chronological order and state how Henry ended each marriage.
8. Create your own word search that uses words related to Shakespeare and the Tudors.
9. In the style of a play script – write a conversation between Henry VIII and one of his wives.
10. Research Tudor food. What would you include in your own feast?
