



Year 1's Spring Term Homework



This homework is related to the learning that will take place this term. Please complete one piece each week and hand it in for marking once that piece is completed. You decide which one you choose to complete weekly. Remember to number each piece of homework.



1. Draw a picture of your favourite toy and label it. Can you write a sentence explaining why it's your favourite toy?



2. Measure 5 toys using a ruler and write your answer in cms. Draw or take a photo of them in height order.



3. Write a book review with a picture of your favourite part of the story. Remember to colour it in!



4. Talk to a relative about the type of toys they played with when they were younger. Write a recount of what you found out about toys in the past. Remember to use your best handwriting!



5. Set up a toyshop at home. Make price labels for your stock and play shops. Use coins to purchase toys (more than one) and work out simple change from 10p and 20p. Can you record your shopping trip? Record your purchases by writing number sentences.



6. Use books from your local library and the internet to research facts about Queen Victoria. Write 5 sentences. Don't forget punctuation!



7. Design your own toy. Explore around and outside your house and look for objects that could safely be used to create a new toy. What did you use?



8. Toy investigation. Have a look at the toys in your house. Sort the toys by their materials and record in a chart or by pictures. Can you find other ways to sort your toys?

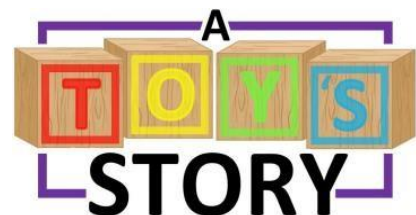
