Settlements	
city	A human settlement of a notable size.
hamlet	A small settlement, generally smaller than a village without a church.
rural	Relating to the countryside – as a location for a settlement.
town	A town is generally larger than a village and smaller than a city.
urban	Relating to a built up area.
village	A village is larger than a hamlet but smaller than a town. Villages are often located in rural areas.

agriculture	The farming of crops and animals.
early settlers	The first people to settle in an area including Romans, Vikings, and Anglo-Saxons.
healthcare	Includes, doctors, dentists, hospitals, etc.
industrial	Businesses that provide products or services.

retail	Shops selling products to people.
settlement	A village, town or city where people live.

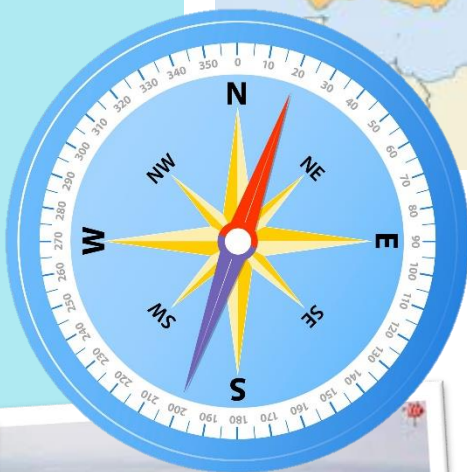
Definitions
