

Class 3 Spellings – Summer 2

This term, the children will be **tested weekly on 10 spellings**. These will be a mixture of **spelling pattern words** and **year 3 / 4 statutory words**. Some words cover both of these!

Every morning, there will be spelling practice time in class; when practising at home, **repetition is key**, along with discussing the meaning of each word.
