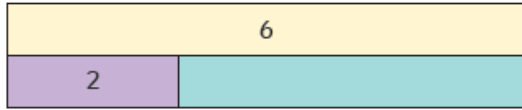

$2 + \underline{\quad} = 6$

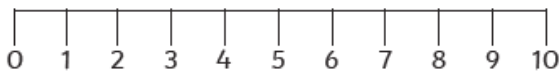


$3 + \underline{\quad} = 8$
